

Year 7 Catch-up Funding 2019/20

Summary of use of intended Catch-up Funding spending

- Intervention tutors employed in English and Maths to work with Year 7 students in groups of 3 for weekly hour sessions.
- Additional programme for literacy improvement will be used to support progress, alongside “Accelerated Reader” programme for Year 7.
- Use of Mastery Maths Curriculum to support progress for Year 7 Maths groups.

Accelerated Reader	£4970	Raise attainment and progress in Literacy	<p>690 pupils are now part of the Accelerated Reader programme.</p> <p>Tracking of pupils shows that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading ages of identified pupils increased at a measurably faster rate than those students who had not been part of the Accelerated Programme in 2019/20
Intervention tutors	£5800	Raise attainment and progress in literacy and numeracy of those students who still require catch up	<p>English: 27% of pupils met or exceeded FFT target having required Catch up intervention. 84% made at least one grades progress towards FFT target or met/exceeded FFT target. The average progress was 2.1 grades from Year 7 catch up cohort, which represents significant progress.</p> <p>Maths: 87% pupils who received intervention are now in line with national expectations for the end of Year 7, based on benchmarked assessment data.</p>
Mastery Curriculum	£2350	Raise attainment and progress in Maths	<p>Maths: Year 7 and 8 All Maths teachers are using the Mastery scheme of learning and resources to deliver the Maths curriculum. All Maths teachers are using standard Mastery assessments and response to feedback lessons. Assessment results show that majority of students are at least in line with expectations.</p>
